

Parish of the Holy Family, East Nottingham Bishop Patrick has issued a formal decree, determining that our current three parishes will be merged to form a single, new parish called Holy Family. A copy of the decree and a map of the new parish boundaries is up at the back of each church and on our website. All three of our churches will retain their current names and have all retained their designation as 'Parish Churches' — equal in status and importance. This change comes into effect this week, on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary (8th December) Our Parish Feast Day will come very soon on Sunday 26th December and will always be the Sunday immediately after Christmas Day. Thank you to everyone who has worked so hard to bring us together over the past few years — it started by working together on Baptism preparation, then our clergy occasionally rotating round for Mass, the formation of one Pastoral Leadership Team, appointment of a Community Coordinator, one Parish Priest and clergy team serving all three churches equally ...... And now we begin the process of creating one Parish Pastoral Council, one Finance Committee, bringing together all bank accounts into one and under one accounting system and planning how to work together ever more closely under the patronage of The Holy Family. May Jesus, Mary and Joseph watch over us and bring us together as one family.
