In the light of the recent removal of all legal restrictions of the pandemic, individual organisations still have to decide on guidelines, so; Holy Water will be restored at the doors of our churches.

Mask wearing is no longer required, but if you are not vaccinated or have underlying health conditions, it is recommended for your own safety. Anyone is welcome to continue wearing a mask if they wish. Personal choice should be respected. Anyone distributing Holy Communion will wear a mask.

Holy Communion will continue to be under one kind only and for the sake of dignity, you are asked to receive on the hand, not tongue. Hand sanitiser will continue to be provided at the doors of our churches. It is not required to be used by those coming up to read, but sacristans, altar servers and those distributing Holy Communion are still asked to use it before handling the sacred vessels. Ventilation of our churches will continue.

Sign of Peace will continue to be offered; it is personal choice whether that is a gesture or handshake.

If you have symptoms of Covid or have tested positive, please do not come to church. We have a duty of care to those who are vulnerable. <u>Mass intentions</u>: If you ask for a Mass to be said for someone who has died, please indicate on the envelope that this is the case. Please only use the pre-printed envelopes to submit Mass intentions, as they prompt you to complete all the information we need. At least a month's notice is needed if a specific date is requested and we cannot guarantee that the request can be fulfilled – the Mass may be said on the nearest available date. It is not possible for the office to let you know when a Mass you have requested is being said – please simply keep an eye on the weekly bulletin.
