WHAT'S IN THE NEWS?

This term, children in Year 3 and 4 will take part in Forest School sessions with Mrs Harrison and Mrs Nicholson. The children will go outside in all weathers so it is essential children wear suitable clothes as they may get muddy. They need a hat, scarf, pair of gloves and bring wellies to wear. Jeans are not suitable clothing for Forest School sessions. It is also important your child doesn't wear their wellies to school, they must have a change of footwear to wear for the rest of the day and when they are outside at break and lunchtime.

Also this term, children in year 5 will be going swimming so need to bring their swimming kit each Wednesday.

We have our talent show finals at the end of the week, well done to all the children who auditioned and congratulations to those who were chosen to go through to the final.

On Friday Chris Ballard who is part of the Nottingham School Sports Partnership is coming into school to work with Year 1, 2 and 5 and teach them some of the basic rules of curling. Children in those classes must wear their PE kit on those days.

Unfortunately, we have a small proportion of children who have started to wear boots with their uniform. These are not acceptable footwear to wear every day. If the weather is cold and you would like your child to wear boots when they are walking to school, they must bring a pair of black school shoes to change into. Trainers are not allowed to be worn on those days when the children wear their uniform.

On PE days children are able to wear plain joggers and a plain navy / black hoodie or a school jumper. Branded clothing is not part of school uniform and will not be allowed to be worn. They are expensive and could get torn but also the children are expected to wear the same uniform so they all feel included and part of our school community. Uniform letters will be given out to those children who are not wearing the correct uniform following a verbal reminder.

Please make a note of our remaining two INSET days this academic year. The first one is on Friday 11th February when staff from all the schools within Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Multi Academy Trust will come together. The final one is Wednesday 27th July. School will be closed for all children on both of these days.

Class 3 were a very close second place with 99.7%


