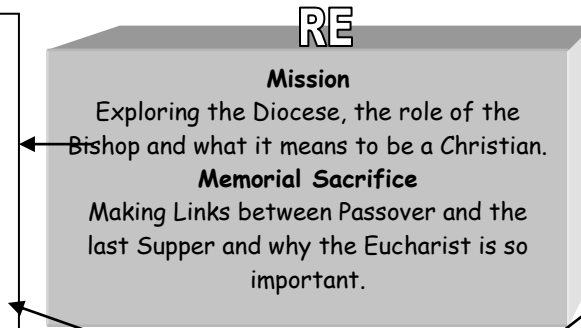


Word of the Week:

What makes Asia so special?

COMPUTING:

To master basic loops in coding.
To learn what functions are and to use them to code a program.

MFL:

To know how to tell if a word is masculine or feminine.
To recognise and say some items of clothing.
To say what someone is wearing.
To understand that word order can be different in French.
To make sentences putting words in the correct order.
To understand that number and gender can affect spelling.

CREATIVE ARTS:

ART/DT

To observe the effect of light from an object from different directions (Planets).
To use techniques to lighten and show tones of the same colour.
To use colour to express moods and feelings and create artwork from a variety of sources - poetry, music.
To use printing to create repeating patterns of 3 colour overlays. To embellish using painting and printing on top of textural work (Batik)

SCIENCE:

To describe the movement of the Earth and other planets in the Solar system relative to the sun.
To describe the movement of the moon relative to the Earth
To use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.
To find out about Tim Peake and his journey to space.
