

PARISH NOTICES:

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion: do you feel called to this ministry? We are on the lookout for more Ministers so if you would like to know more please have a word with Father Joe. There is a compulsory Diocesan Course coming up, which must be attended.

Receiving Holy Communion: we are still not permitted to restore the reception of the Precious Blood at Communion ... but we are still able to receive the Host. A reminder that when we come up to receive, we form an altar with our hands (one under the other), answer 'Amen' when the priest or minster says 'The Body of Christ' and then we pick up the Host from our hand and consume it immediately. It is permitted to receive Communion on the tongue, but for the sake of hygiene and to avoid transmission of virus, if someone does receive the Host on their tongue, the priest or minister will then return to the altar and sanitise their hands before resuming the distribution of Communion. Therefore, it would make sense if someone does want to receive on the tongue, you wait and come up at the end of the line. Thank you for your cooperation. **Diocesan Events for families**:
