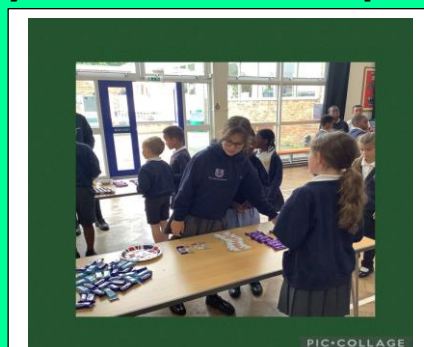

## **PARISH NOTICES:**

**New Assistant Priest:** in September, we will be joined by Fr Philip Heiberg, who will take up post as Assistant Priest in the parish to replace Fr Liam. Philip is a priest of the Diocese of Shrewsbury who has been working with our diocese for the past year, in St Mary's Derby. He will be joining the Pastoral Team as Assistant Priest and we look forward to welcoming him to the Holy Family Parish.

**Security at Sacred Heart Church:** due to recent incidents of theft and vandalism, Sacred Heart will be locked outside of the usual service times. It is hoped that this is temporary, but in the last two weeks, a money box on a candle stand has been stolen and this past week, someone broke into the sacristy from the church, probably looking for money. Nothing was taken, but the inner door has been damaged and cannot be secured. Until this is mended, the church must be kept locked.

**Second collection this weekend** for Peter's Pence for the Church's universal needs and sent to The Pope.

**Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion:** do you feel called to this ministry? We are on the lookout for more Ministers so, if you would like to know more, please have a word with Father Joe. There is a compulsory Diocesan Course coming up, which must be attended.

**Receiving Holy Communion:** we are still not permitted to restore the reception of the Precious Blood at Communion ... but we are still able to receive the Host. A reminder that when we come up to receive, we form an altar with our hands (one under the other), answer 'Amen' when the priest or minister says 'The Body of Christ' and then we pick up the Host from our hand and consume it immediately. It is permitted to receive Communion on the tongue, but for the sake of hygiene and to avoid transmission of virus, if someone does receive the Host on their tongue, the priest or minister will then return to the altar and sanitise their hands before resuming the distribution of Communion. Therefore, it would make sense if someone does want to receive on the tongue, you wait and come up at the end of the line. Thank you for your cooperation.

Cardinal Manning (d. 1892) called unjust working conditions "a public evil, that should excite public condemnation - and our solidarity".

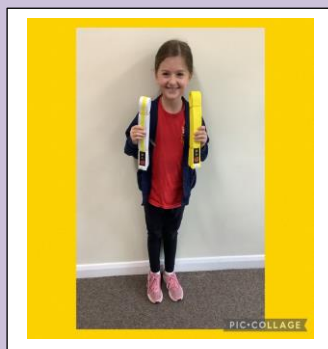


## SPORTING NEWS
