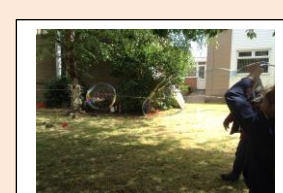

## **PARISH NOTICES:**

**Services of Word and Holy Communion:** these services, led by a Eucharistic Minister, sometimes take the place of Mass when priests have other commitments. From September, when Mass is happening in the parish at another place, we will not be putting on a Service of Word and Holy Communion in another one of our churches. Instead, we will still have a service at the time Mass would normally happen, but it will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Morning Prayer of the Church, Rosary or something similar. This means that there will still be an opportunity to gather to pray. This is to fall in with Church teaching, that if there is Mass in the parish on any given day, there should not be a SWHC in the parish too. We will be looking for people who would be willing to lead prayer in the parish and will provide some training in leading prayer .... so keep an eye out.

**New Assistant Priest:** in September, we will be joined by Fr Philip Heiberg, who will take up post as Assistant Priest in the parish to replace Fr Liam. Philip is a priest of the Diocese of Shrewsbury who has been working with our diocese for the past year, in St Mary's Derby. He will be joining the Pastoral Team as Assistant Priest and we look forward to welcoming him to the Holy Family Parish.

**Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion:** do you feel called to this ministry? We are on the lookout for more Ministers so, if you would like to know more, please have a word with Father Joe. There is a compulsory Diocesan Course coming up, which must be attended.

**Synod corner.** What's happened as a result of the Synod that we took part in earlier in the year?

1. Diocesan Synod report has gone off to feed into the global Synod <https://www.dioceseofnottingham.uk/synod>

2. The Pastoral Team and Parish Pastoral Council both looked at the Synod responses from our parish and identified two priorities:

a. Formation of adults in the faith. To address this, our Adult Formation Coordinator has organised a retreat day for catechists on 22nd October and a Parish retreat Day for Advent on the 10th December, both with input from international Catholic speaker David Wells. This is in addition to everything we currently offer for adults to grow in their faith.

b. Supporting young people in growing in their faith and belonging to the Church. Holy Family parish is working with several other parishes in Nottingham to look at the possibility of employing a full-time Youth Worker to support our parishes in working with young people of secondary school age. The Diocesan Youth Service is helping us explore this. This isn't all that we are doing as a parish, there are plenty of other things happening too; plans for more coach trips and pilgrimages following on from our successful trip to Walsingham; Live Simply Group formed across the parish; Parish Ministry party in September; social gatherings planned for the autumn .....

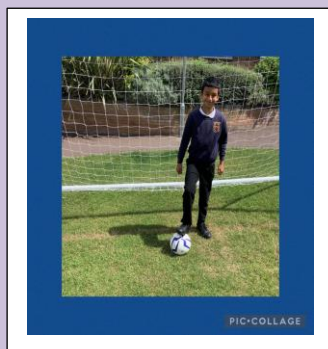


## SPORTING NEWS
