# **DAART GRADUATION**

Over the past ten weeks our year 5 children have been taken part in weekly DAaRT sessions. This is a new programme that has replaced DARE – it stands for Drug, Awareness and Resilience Training. The children have worked with an experienced DAaRT officer covering a range of life skills.

#### Key topics have included:

- Illegal and legal drugs including alcohol, tobacco, solvents, prescription drugs.
- Hate crime covering difference, prejudice and respect
- Knife crime includes the law, safety and risks and consequences

- Where to get help

# TRANSFER TO RECEPTION CLASS IN SEPTEMBER 2023

The window for applying for a reception place for your child for September 2023 is now open and closes on 15th January 2023. If you apply after the deadline this may reduce your chances of getting a place at your preferred school, particularly if it is popular.

Although your child currently attends our nursery, this does not guarantee you a place in Reception. If your child is baptised Catholic or a member of another Christian denomination, you must complete a supplementary form and share their Baptism / Christening certificate with us. If you do not provide the supporting evidence your child will be placed in a lower ranked category. We have to follow the admissions criteria from the diocese so it is important you visit other schools and list them too on your application. Failure to do so will mean the City Council will place your child in a school where there is a space available.
