

#### **WELCOME TO JET!!**

We are incredibly excited to introduce you to a new member that will be joining us in school next week. We will be welcoming Jet as a certified assistant hearing dog for deaf people. Jet is a 4 year old Labrador x Golden Retriever. He has been a certified hearing dog since May 2021 and is very excited to become an integral part of our school community.

### What are the benefits of having a school dog?

Numerous research studies have shown the benefits of dogs in school. Evidence indicates that benefits include;

- Cognitive-companionship with a dog stimulates memory and problem solving.
- Social- a dog provides a positive mutual topic for discussion, encourages responsibility, wellbeing and focused interaction with others
- Emotional- school dogs improve self-esteem, acceptance from others and lift mood, often provoking laughter and fun. Dogs can also teach compassion and respect for other living things as well as relieving anxiety.
- Reading-reading to dogs has been proven to help children develop
  Literacy skills and build confidence, through both the calming effect
  the dog's presence has on children as well as the fact that a dog will
  listen to children read without being judgemental or critical. This
  comforting environment helps to nurture children's enthusiasm for
  reading and provides them with the confidence to read aloud.

#### **ATTENDANCE SHOUT OUTS!!**


