PARISH NOTICES:

Advent and Christmas in Holy Family Parish – For service times take a leaflet from church or visit our website. Give one to your family and friends and ask them to come along – they are waiting to be asked.

Next weekend could be confusing! Sunday morning is the 24th Dec, but is still Advent, so we will have two Masses for this 4th Sunday of Advent; 9am at OLSE and 11.30am at SA.

Then Sunday evening is the start of Christmas; Masses are 5pm at SH and 6.30pm at OLSE. Monday morning is Christmas morning, with Masses at 9am SH and 10.30 SA. The ministry rotas in the newsletter are for the 4th Sunday of Advent.

Last call!! Forms for CONFIRMATION preparation programme (Confirmation by Bishop Patrick is on 18th October 2024), and 1ST HOLY COMMUNION 2024 preparation (for those in school year 3 and above), MUST be returned to church THIS Sunday 17th December. Forms are available at the back of church. No forms received after this date will be accepted.

Hymn Books: the hymn books at Our Lady & St Edward's and St Augustine's are very tired looking and a bit out of date. We plan to replace them in the next few months with Laudate; this is the best Catholic hymn book on the market and it will mean that we all use the same book across the three churches. If you would like to dedicate a hymn book for a particular intention, take a green form from the back of church and return it with a donation; suggested amount £10. The dedication can be in memory of someone who has died or any other prayer intention. It's lovely to open a hymn book and see a prayer request. There will be 150 books each at OLSE and SA. There are a few books at Sacred Heart without dedications, but most already have them in from a few years ago. Any current dedications in hymn books at OLSE will be transferred over.

School admissions to Catholic Primary Academies (Reception Year) -Children born between 01/09/2019 and 31/08/2020. The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 15th January 2024. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you should also complete a supplementary information form and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You MUST also include the supporting evidence* as required with this form, eg baptism certificate (photocopies acceptable). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place.

*If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.

Message from Bishop's House: The ongoing reorganisation of the diocese, enabling us all to become more missionary in a way which recognises that we now have fewer clergy and fewer parishioners, continues to make steady progress. To date the 108 parishes we had in 2017 have been reduced to 88, with 32 parishes having been amalgamated to form 12 new larger parishes. Parishioners in all our parishes are on a journey of working more closely together, in a more missionary fashion, in our united effort to proclaim the love of Jesus Christ, and to put that love into practice across the East Midlands.

TRANSFER TO RECEPTION CLASS IN SEPTEMBER 2024

The window for applying for a reception place for your child for September 2024 is now open and closes on 15th January 2024. If you apply after the deadline this may reduce your chances of getting a place at your preferred school, particularly if it is popular.

Although your child currently attends our nursery, this does not guarantee you a place in Reception. We have to follow the admissions criteria from the diocese so it is important you visit other schools and list them too on your application. Failure to do so will mean the City Council will place your child in a school where there is a space available.

Thank you to all the parents who join Nursery and Reception each Friday morning to support with reading. We really appreciate your support. We are looking at implementing this throughout school in the new year.
