Geography

- Revisit Australia/Oceania. Name and locate Asia on a world map. Name the 7 continents, 5 oceans, equator, tropics.
- Naming and locating some of the main countries and their capital cities. (China, India, Pakistan, Japan, Singapore, Saudi Arabia, Iran). Looking at the **physical features** of Asia including mountain ranges (Himalayas, Karakoram) rivers (Mekong, Yangtze, Ganges, Ob, Indus).
- Regional study India** Fact file (**human & physical**) population, landmarks (man-made Taj Mahal vs natural Himalayan mountains, Ganges & Indian desert) changes to country, trade & economic activities. Traffic and congestion.
- Make comparisons between India and Nottingham/UK.
